About Orange Shirt Day

Orange Shirt Day began in 2013 by the Orange Shirt Society in Williams Lake, BC. The purpose of the Society and Day are:

- To support Indian Residential School Reconciliation;
- To create awareness of the individual, family and community intergenerational impacts of Indian Residential Schools through Orange Shirt Society activities;
- To create awareness of the concept of "Every Child Matters"



Every Child Matters is a slogan that symbolizes that every child is important, including the ones who lost their lives and the adults who are still healing from their difficult time at Residential Schools.

The efforts of the Orange Shirt Society and partners have resulted in countless resolutions of support by local, provincial and federal governments, school districts and First Nations. It has brought national and international attention to the legacy of Residential Schools and helped shape the establishment of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, which reached Royal Assent in 2021 and Statutory Holiday status by several provinces in 2023.


